ANOINTING OF THE SICK AND COMMUNION FOR HOMEBOUND AT SAINT IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA PARISH AND MISSION CHURCHES.

We invite you to contact the parish office at (970) 563-4241 to be put in touch with the parish priest in order to schedule Anointing of the Sick for yourself. If the anointing request is on behalf of another person, please be sure to get the approval of the person if the person is mentally capable of doing so, this is in order to avoid uncomfortable situations for both the priest and/or the person.

While this sacrament is intended for those who suffer from a serious bodily ailment due to injury, illness, or old age, it is **not necessary** to wait for someone be at the point of death to receive Anointing. It is actually more profitable for the person to be alert of the anointing and do a confession of sins.

Homebound visits are ordinarily done on Wednesday or Friday of each week. **IF THIS DAY DOES NOT WORK** or it's an **EMERGENCY** please leave the information below and the priest will contact you to arrange a convenient day for both.

PLEASE, LEAVE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WHEN REQUESTING A HOME/HOSPITAL/ HOSPICE VISIT:

- Name and phone number of the Sick person AND the name and phone number of the caller and their relationship to the Sick. (Family member, friend, chaplain)
- Is the caller or the Sick person a parishioner of Saint Ignatius of Loyola Parish, St. Bartholomew Church or St. Peter and St. Rose?
- Has the Sick person requested the visit? If not, does the Sick approve of this request?
- Location of the Sick (address, room number, any restricted hours?)
- Purpose of the visit (Anointing, Communion, Confession, consultation?)
