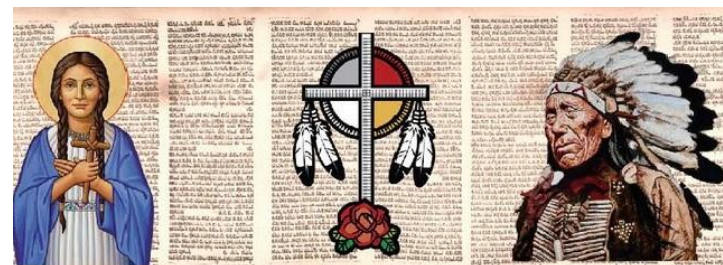

SAVE THE DATE: Durango's Court St. Anthony of the Catholic
Daughters of the Americas is excited to offer a **pilgrimage to
France July 28-August 7, 2026**. Some highlights of our pilgrimage
will be **Paris**, the "City of Lights" with many historic sites, where
there will be the opportunity to explore and have masses at **Sacre'
Coeur, Notre Dame Cathedral and the Chapel where our Blessed
Mother manifested the Miraculous Medal to St. Catherine
Laboure in 1830**. Then, we will get to visit **Lisieux, home of the
Little Flower, Saint Thérèse**. We will have mass at her convent
with the Carmelite Nuns of Lisieux. There will also be an
opportunity to explore **Omaha Beach**, the site of D-Day where
American soldiers stormed the beach during World War II. In
